THE PLANNING INSPECTORATE PROCESS

Pre-application – applicant creates detailed application

Acceptance - PI have 28 days window to decide - may contact affected in the area

Pre-examination – interested parties register to have a say – usually 3 months

Examination – lots of deadlines – online statements or attend hearings

Recommendation - must be written and submitted to SoS within 3 months of end of examination

Decision - SoS has 3 months to review and make a decision
